Minutes	02/18.	The Clerk to the Parish Council was authorised to take the minutes by unanimous vote.
	03/18.	The minutes of the previous Annual Assembly held on 20th March 2017 were read to the meeting. The minutes were agreed as a true record and were authorised to be signed by the Chairman. Proposed Councillor Bradley Seconded Councillor Crawford
To Receive issues from the public	04/18.	Mr Cook noted that the Neighbourhood Watch Scheme has been advised that the police will reintroduce bike patrols over the summer period.
	05/18	Councillor Shaw asked what had happened to the parish council supported police quad bikes, they appear to have been disbanded. Mr Knight asked if the bicycles could be kept in the parish and the police pick them up from here and return them once the patrol is over. This item is to be raised with the police when they attend the Harley Mission meetings.
	06/18.	it was asked if various potholes could be attended to within the parish, notably on Kirby Lane, Barrow Hill , also the road markings need reinstating at the junction of Kirby Lane and Sheffield Road and on Hague Lane when carriageway repairs have been undertaken.
	07/18.	There is debris from a motor accident on Dike Hill, Mr Knight commented that a litter pick due in the next few weeks would clear it up. Mr Cook noted that if the proposal to reduce the size of refuse bins is implemented by RMBC, there would be no space to dispose of the litter picked waste.
	08/18.	Mr Cook noted that community speed checks are not carried out in poor weather, the police have strict criteria for conditions in which to carry out speed checks.
	09/18.	Councillor Dickerson noted that the hedges at Barley Hole need cutting.
	10/18.	The next meeting was confirmed as the 18th March 2019
	11/18.	The Chairman thanked the attendees and closed the meeting
