



| Matters Raised By Parishioners 4665. | Mrs Cook raised the matter of the pavements near to the Almshouses, she has reported them to RMBC who have declared them not to be their responsibility and that they will refer the matter to Wentworth Estates. | | |

| Matters Arising 4668. | Two quotes have been received for the new Wentworth notice board, the quote for a hardwood board was proposed. Proposed Councillor Crawford Seconded Councillor Dickerson Resolved By unanimous vote the quote for a hardwood notice board be accepted. 4669. The signs for Barley Hole have not yet been completed, clerk to prompt Streetpride 4670. Councillor Bradley raised further concerns about the speed limit on Cortworth Lane, near to the junction at Nether Haugh. RMBC have been asked to escalate the matter higher as the response received was not considered to be acceptable. 4671. A planning application has been received for a property on Kirby Lane, no objections were raised. 4672. A response has been received from Wentworth Estates on the matter of a contribution to the ongoing remedial work required on the Harley play equipment. The Estate does not propose to contribute to the work. 4673. RMBC has responded to the request to consider width restrictions along Kirby Lane and Harley Road, a restriction is not considered appropriate for the two carriageways. 4374. A litter pick is to be requested for Kirby Lane. 4375. A request has been received from the air ambulance to attend the Wentworth village day event. It was proposed that the request be granted subject to the appropriate health and safety measures being in place. The air ambulance will be allowed to collect donations on the day.
