<p>Matters Raised By Parishioners 5442.</p>	<p>The Harley residents attended the meeting to raise concerns about damage to their property by cricket balls coming from the Harley cricket pitch. There has been serious damage over many years, but the frequency and severity of the damage is increasing. The situation is affecting the residents ability to use their gardens on match days and causing undue stress. Members were concerned about the level of damage and the issues it causes and are to hold a meeting with the residents and officials of the cricket club to try to come to some mutual agreement that will stop the damage occurring. <p>Matters Arising 5443.</p>	<p>Members considered the RMBC proposal to partially remove the double yellow lines along Main Street to ease the problem of traffic speed, it would in effect make parked vehicles unofficial traffic calming measures. It was agreed that official calming measures were needed and that the parish council would not support the removal of any of the yellow lines along Main Street. Councillor Roche commented that there was no RMBC funding available for official traffic calming measures and that the introduction of 20mph zones has proved ineffective and impossible to enforce, but will be used near schools during normal school hours. Councillor Hunton has sent written confirmation that he is against the proposal.</p> <p>It was proposed that the yellow lines along Main Street should not be removed, either in total or partially</p> <p>Proposed Councillor Bradley Seconded Councillor McNamara</p> <p>Resolved By unanimous vote the yellow lines should not be altered.</p>		<p>DR</p>
