Minutes 6601.	The minutes of the meeting held on 17th June 2024 are accepted as a true record and are authorised to be signed by the Chairman. Proposed Councillor Knight Seconded Councillor Shaw																																															
Matters Raised By Parishioners 6602.	There have been a few more complaints from parishioners about the bus service, a couple of the services did not turn up. The company has been contacted about the missed services, but has not responded.																																															
6603.	There has been a complaint about overgrown hedges along Clayfield Lane, the matter has been forwarded to Wentworth Estates.																																															
6604.	The hedges along Coaley Lane between the junctions with Street Lane and Linthwaite Lane are overhanging the pavement and need cutting back. There has also been a complaint about the hedges along Angel Lane. Matter to be referred to Wentworth Estates																																															
6605.	RMBC has cut the hedges of the resident bordering the Harley playing field.																																															
6606.	The gullies along Coaley Lane need cleansing, they are blocked solid. Also the slow road markings need refreshing																																															
6607.	The issue of standing water near the properties at the top of Barrowfield Lane has not been resolved, matter to be reported to RMBC again.

A near miss was reported on the road. Both matters to be raised with the Estate.</p> <p>It was noted that there has been weed killer sprayed along the hedge where the footpath is at Harley and it looks unsightly as it is dying back. The grounds maintenance contractor is to be contacted to ascertain who has sprayed the area.</p> <p>Some litter has been left on the Harley field after the gala, the Harley Activity Group are to be asked to do a litter pick.</p> <p>After a recent planning application submitted by Thorncliffe & Wentworth CC, it appears that the Wentworth pavilion could be subject to business rates</p> <p>The Tour of Britain race is to pass through Harley and Wentworth on the 5th September.</p> <p>The crash barrier along the A6135 at Lodge Drive has still not been replaced.
