<b>Minutes</b>	<b>02/24.</b>	The Clerk to the Parish Council was authorised to take the minutes by unanimous vote.
	<b>03/24.</b>	The minutes of the previous Annual Assembly held on 27th March 2023 were read to the meeting. The minutes were agreed as a true record and were authorised to be signed by the Chairman.

<b>Matters Arising</b>	<b>04/24.</b>	An update was given on the concerns raised last year, the bus service has now been reinstated. The request for hand rails at the war memorial was passed to the Estate which declined to add rails due to the proximity of the public footpath. The request for the disabled car parking bay markings to be repainted has also been declined by the Estate in the near term, due to larger works being planned for the car park
	<b>05/24</b>	There are no plans to open up the top field for villagers parking on Village Day, the area has previously only been used for vendor parking. It will not be open this year due to a cricket match on the same day. The complaints about the skip not being properly advertised have been address for this year The purchase of a lock for the notice board wasn't really feasible and would cause problems with access.
	<b>06/24.</b>	The village beacon has been refurbished and the trees in the car park and playing field are to be crown lifted. The bench replacements have been done and a list and map of parish council benches is on the website along with a list of other parish council achievements.
<b>To Receive issues from the public</b>	<b>07/24</b>	Mr Hunton has forwarded concerns about the disabled car parking markings and the signage at the Harley bends, Both matters have been addressed and new signage has been requested.
	<b>08/24</b>	Mr & Mrs Maestro raised the matter of the dilapidated A sign for residents parking in Friers Croft As members of the WVCA, which purchased the sign many years ago they wanted permission to now dispose of it as it as rotted to at least two pieces. It is thought prudent to consult with the residents of Friers Croft before any action is taken.
	<b>09/24</b>	The next meeting was confirmed as the 17th March 2025
