Upcoming works in Wentworth – come along to drop in event to find out more

We're getting in touch to let you know that Yorkshire Water, along with our delivery partners MMB, will be carrying out essential works in Wentworth to help improve local infrastructure and protect the environment. These are due to start on **Monday 22 September**.

This £3 million investment will involve installing a new sewage pumping station off Cortworth Lane, a 1.25km rising main, and a gravity sewer. These upgrades will intercept wastewater flow from Wentworth Garden Centre, transferring it to the Aldwarke wastewater treatment site.

To carry out the work safely and efficiently, traffic management will be in place as follows:

- From 22 September (approx. 3–4 weeks): Full closure of Hague Lane at the junction with Main Street / Cortworth Lane. Access to Wentworth Garden Centre will be maintained via Thorpe Hesley and will still be accessible via footpath.
- From 6 October (approx. 8 weeks): Temporary traffic signals on Cortworth Lane, starting at the Hague Lane junction.
- **January 2026:** Night-time closures at the Cortworth Lane / Hague Lane junction.

Please note that these dates may be subject to change.

We're committed to keeping you informed and minimising disruption. To support this, we're hosting a **community drop-in event** on **Thursday 25 September**, **4pm - 7pm**, at the **Mechanics Institute**, **Main Street**, **Wentworth**.

Come along to meet the project team, ask questions, and learn more about the work.
